**TRAIN OPERATION BULLETIN**

Steam Train: Locomotive Cab Access

---

Commencing with the start of steam train operations in 2008, locomotive cab access by the public is now restricted. In order to enhance revenue and to be consistent with the practice at our other railroad museum, we will now charge a fee of \$25.00 for the public to ride in the cab of a steam locomotive. Tickets will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis at the Wabuska Depot ticket window with a limit of two riders per trip. No one under the age of 6 is permitted to ride in the cab; all riders over the age of 6 shall be subject to the \$25.00 ticket fee. Current members of the *Friends of the Nevada State Railroad Museum* will receive a 50% discount to ride in the cab. Orange "complimentary" ride tickets are not valid for cab rides. Steam locomotive tenders have signs advising the public of this new policy. Locomotive crews and the train conductor may allow for cab access by the public at no charge while the train is parked at the Depot.
