**New Train Tickets** 

Commencing with the start of the 2008 public train ride season, new tickets will be issued by the Agent at Wabuska. The new tickets are the same for the motor car and steam train per the following schedule:

ADULT: Blue
CHILD: Yellow
SENIOR: Green
COMPLIMENTARY: Orange


CAB RIDE: Red (tickets available after May 19, 2008)

These new tickets are two-piece; with a tear-off perforated Conductor stub. Riders may write-in their home zip code on the ticket stub for later compilation of rider demographics. The Wabuska Agent shall date stamp the upper portion of the ticket and Conductor or Car Attendant will punch this part of the ticket when presented on the train. Conductors and Car Attendants shall turn in all stubs at the end of the day or shift.

All Conductors and Car Attendants are asked to remind train riders that the ticket may be presented for discounted same-day admission to the Museum's Jacobsen Interpretive Center (\$1.00 admission discount) and a 10% store purchase discount, again valid on date of issue only (see reverse side of ticket).

There is no change to the policy with respect to valid age categories or the discount program for *Friends* members.
