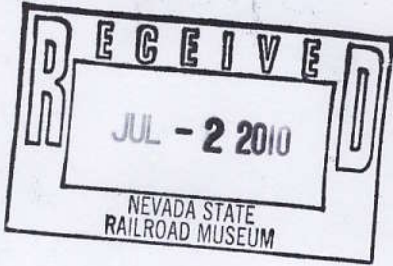


Dear Friends:
