Call to order - Meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM

Representing the museum were Dan Thielen and Adam Michalski. A quorum was established. Also participating were Chris MacMahon, Taylor McCready, Nancy Humphries, and Todd Moore.

Minutes of the June 1, 2020 regular meeting were approved. Motion to approve made by Rick Kohler, second by Ron Allen.

Correspondence – Letter was sent to John H. White, Jr thanking him for a donation of funds to the Friends.

Treasurer's report – See attached report. Motion to approve made by Rebecca Bevans, seconded by Ron Allen. Motion passed.

Larry Knack reported that expenses previously approved for Covid-19 supplies and Plexiglas were not needed. The battery for the motorcar that was approved at the last meeting cost \$20 more than the approved amount. A motion was made by Larry Knack, seconded by Rebecca Bevans that the additional \$20 be approved. Motion passed

Larry reported that previously approved amounts of \$170 and \$420 have been deducted for the Friends quarterly payment to the museum. This was done because the requested expenses were considered museum overhead and did not fall within the Friends mission.

A discussion was held regarding the transfer of funds from the checking account to the money market. Motion made by Rick Kohler, seconded by Ron Allen that \$10,000 be transferred from checking to money market. Motion carried.

Rick Kohler will look into better paying savings plans that would be appropriate for the Friends to utilize.

Dan Thielen announced that the contract is ready to be issued to complete the 3rd rail on the loop. Hopefully this will be completed by the time of Santa Train operations.
